As a condition of authorizing the addition of sewage flow into the City's Sewer System, the Commissioner of the Department of Watershed Management for the City of Atlanta must:

- Certify the availability of adequate capacity to convey, transmit, and treat increased sewage flow or,
- Require the completion of offsetting sewer improvements to the City's system or,
- Assure that the applicant has received all required approvals for alternative sewage disposal techniques where adequate capacity is not available.

Should adequate capacity require the completion of offsetting sewer improvements, approval of applications for building permits may be made, however a Certificate of Occupancy shall not be given until the offsetting sewer improvements are completed.

Securing the certification of adequate capacity from the Commissioner of Watershed Management is a requirement of the City Ordinance, Section 154-145, entitled "Plans and specifications generally" and is consistent with the requirements of Section VII.B.8. of the First Amended Consent Decree (Civil Action No. 1:98-CV-1956-TWT), a copy of which may be examined in the office of the Department of Watershed Management.

Should adequate capacity require the completion of offsetting sewer improvements, approval of applications for building permits may be made, however a Certificate of Occupancy shall not be given until the offsetting sewer improvements are completed. If none of the above conditions are met, no building permit, conditional or otherwise, shall be issued.

If the project scope and/or the calculation of sewage flows referenced herein is revised, the Applicant must amend this Application and any pending Bureau of Building permit application for the proposed project, in a timely manner.
