



## Atlanta's Sewer System Evaluation Survey:

***WE'RE COMING*** to your neighborhood,  
but our arrival has been **delayed!**

Dear Citizen:

We notified you within the last few months about the City of Atlanta's ***Sewer System Evaluation Survey (SSES)***. We made a commitment then to keep you informed about work in your area, and we're **serious** about that commitment. We're writing today to let you know that

***Work in your area was postponed and is rescheduled to start within the next few days.***

Through the SSES project, the City will inspect about 2,200 miles of sewer lines looking for breaks, collapses, and blockages. City workers and contractors will be performing manhole inspections, non-toxic smoke and dye testing, flow isolation, building plumbing locations/inspection, CCTV (Closed Circuit Television) inspection of sewer lines, and temporary flow, rain gauge and pump station monitoring.

***Crews may be working in your area for approximately 3 to 6 weeks.***
